## Evaluation

## Evaluation

- Coalhurst Elementary School continues to demonstrate excellence in provincial achievement tests, with an impressive 79% of students meeting the acceptable standard, surpassing the provincial average of 63%. While maintaining a high level of performance, the school acknowledges a slight decline compared to pre-COVID levels in relation to achievement of the standard of excellence. In response, the school is redoubling efforts to reinforce fundamental skills in reading, writing, and mathematics. This proactive approach reflects the school's commitment to addressing challenges head-on, ensuring that students receive the support necessary to excel in these essential areas and maintain the outstanding academic standards for which Coalhurst Elementary is known.

## Evaluation

- Coalhurst Elementary School (CES) has excelled in creating a positive learning environment, with an impressive 88% agreement rate among teachers, parents, and students. This exceeds the provincial norm of 84.7%, highlighting CES's success in fostering a welcoming, caring, respectful, and safe atmosphere within the school community.
- The decline in the agreement rate from 92.7% to 88% signals a small shift in perception regarding the positive learning environment at Coalhurst Elementary School. This decrease suggests a potential change or challenge in factors contributing to the school's atmosphere. It is important for the school administration to investigate the reasons behind this decline, gather feedback from stakeholders, and take proactive measures to address any concerns. Identifying and addressing the underlying issues can help restore and enhance the positive learning environment for teachers, parents, and students at Coalhurst Elementary School.

## Evaluation

- Coalhurst Elementary School (CES) has demonstrated strong performance in the provision of appropriate supports and services for students, with an overall agreement rate of 88.7%. This exceeds the provincial average of 80.6%, indicating that CES is successful in ensuring that parents, students, and teachers believe students have access to the necessary resources.
- However, a closer look reveals a decline in student respondents' agreement regarding appropriate supports and services, dropping from 88.5% last year to 81.5% this year. This decline may signal a shift in student perception or indicate potential areas for improvement in the support services provided. Understanding the reasons behind this decrease is essential

for the school to address specific concerns and enhance the support systems for students.

- On a positive note, 89.2% of parent respondents and 95.3% of teacher respondents agree that students have access to appropriate supports and services. These high percentages from parents and teachers suggest that the school's efforts are recognized and valued by these stakeholders.

## Evaluation

Coalhurst Elementary School (CES) has achieved a high level of satisfaction among parents and teachers regarding parental involvement in decisions about their child's education. Overall, 83.6% of parents and teachers are satisfied, compared with 79.1% provincially. Specifically:

- **Parent Satisfaction:** 70.3% of parents at CES express satisfaction with their involvement in decisions about their child's education. This signifies a positive perception of the school's efforts to engage and include parents in the educational process.
- **Teacher Satisfaction:** Teachers at CES also exhibit a high level of satisfaction, with the percentage reaching 96.9%. This suggests that educators at the school appreciate and value the collaboration with parents in shaping and supporting students' educational experiences.

- Coalhurst Elementary School (CES) parents express a satisfaction rate of 70.3% regarding their involvement in decisions about their child's education. In comparison, the provincial average among parent respondents is slightly higher at 72.5%. While CES falls slightly below the provincial average in this regard, it's essential for the school to continue exploring ways to enhance and encourage parental involvement to bridge this gap and ensure a more robust partnership between parents and the school in decision-making processes.
